Assistant Superintendent, Chuck Reynolds, provided an update on preliminary enrollment comparison. He reviewed the elementary, intermediate, and high school levels.

Chuck Reynolds presented highlights from Cohort I, which just graduated: 38% are going to Ivy Tech, 23% attending IUE, 25% are attending a different 4-year Indiana college, the remaining are attending college out of state, and two students are pursuing cosmetology.
