Garrison Elementary Appraisal

Ms. Karen Scalf discussed the details of the Garrison Elementary Appraisal. It is the opinion of the appraiser that the 12 acre parcel of land, should the structure be razed, including the parking lot, would appraise at \$57,000. The property as is, currently is valued at \$32,900. Attorney Ron Cross will be further evaluating this information. It is also the opinion of the appraiser that the market value of the property could range from donation to a not for profit or government agency to a high of \$50,000. The board is referring this information to the Finance Committee for a more thorough discussion. The Finance Committee will meet in a public meeting on November 11, 2014 at 1:30 p.m. in the Administration Building.
