

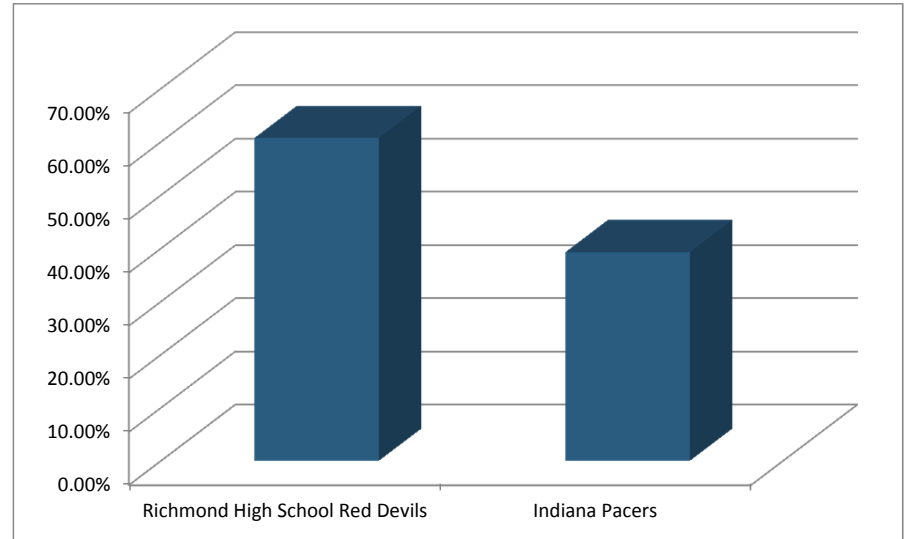

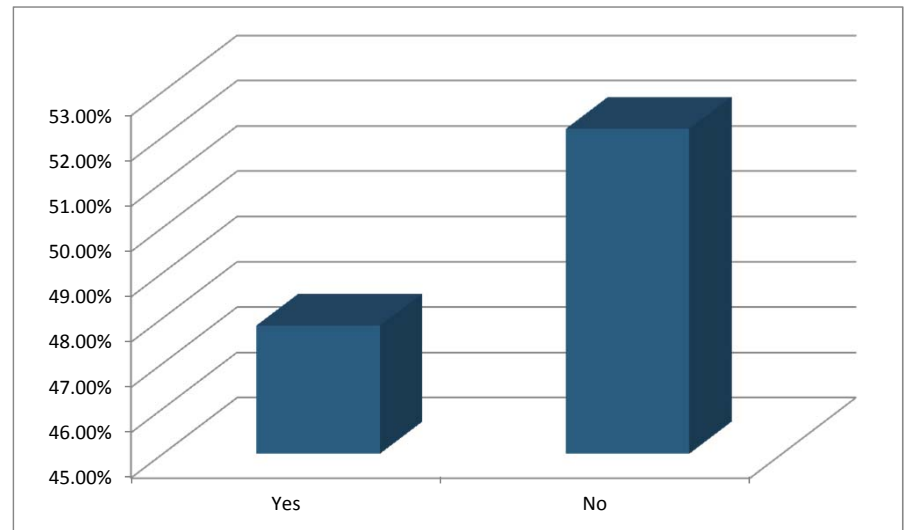
1. Who is going to have the better basketball season record? (Multiple Choice)

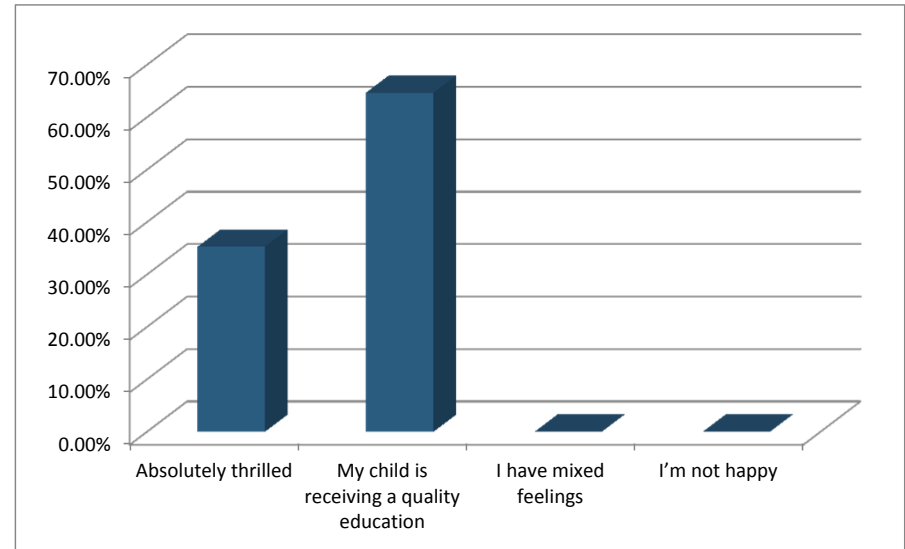
2. Do you have children or grandchildren attending Richmond Community Schools? (Multiple Choice)

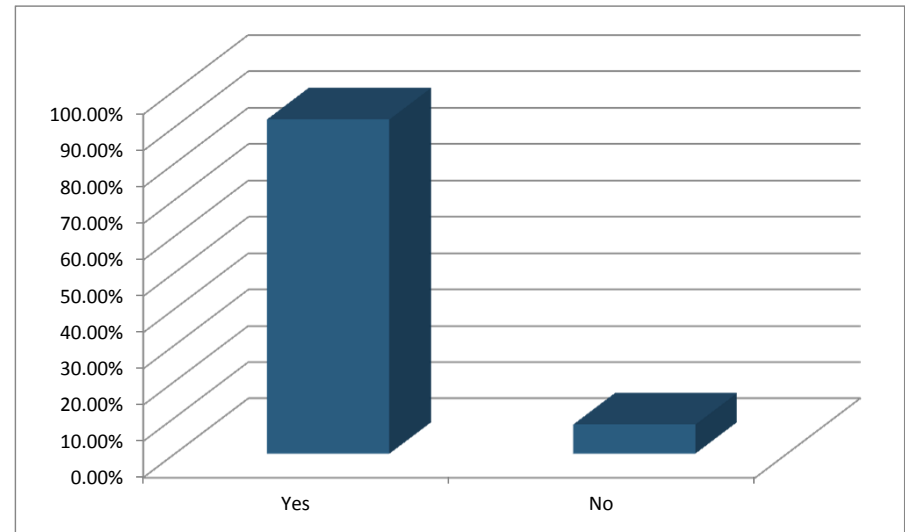

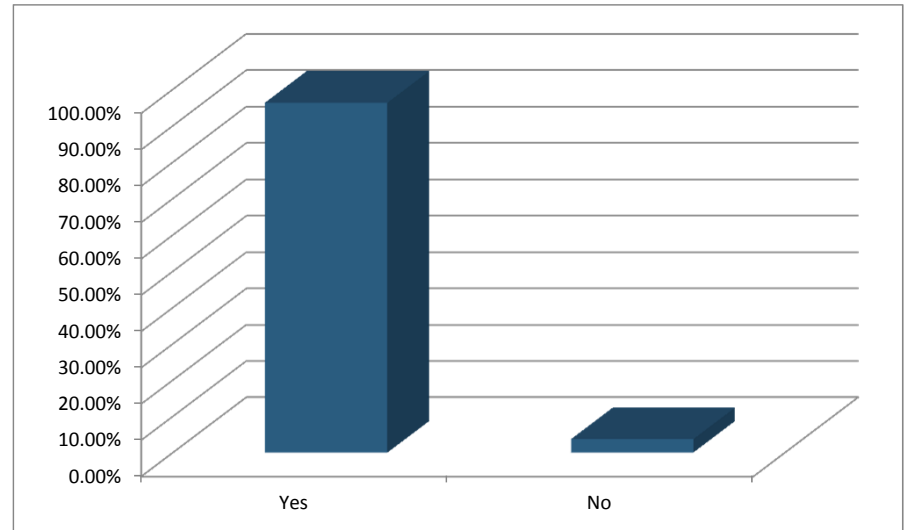

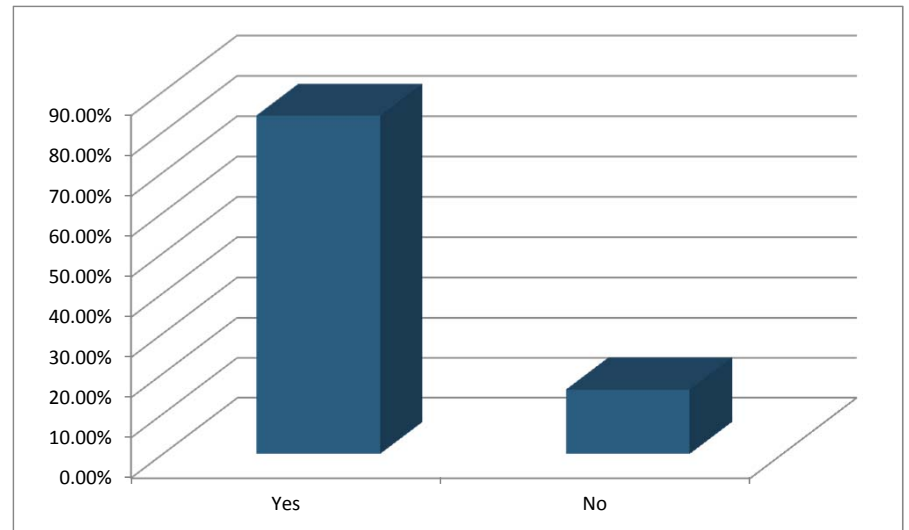

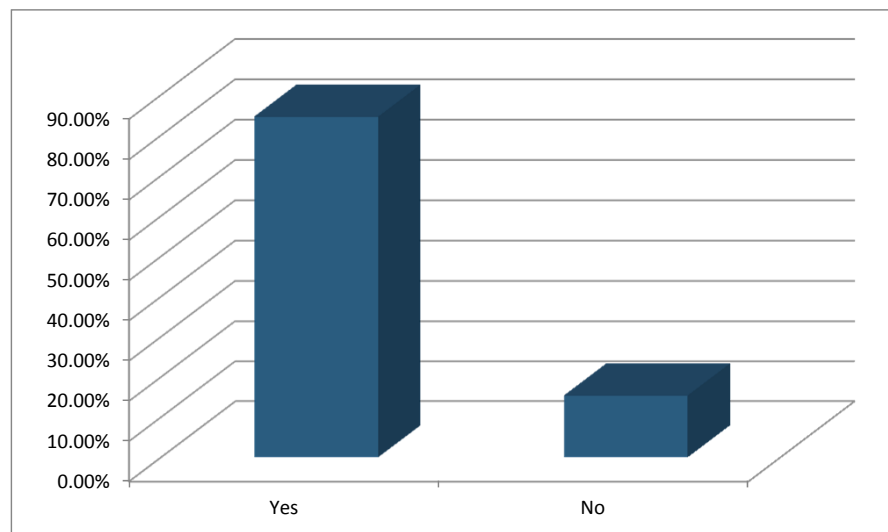

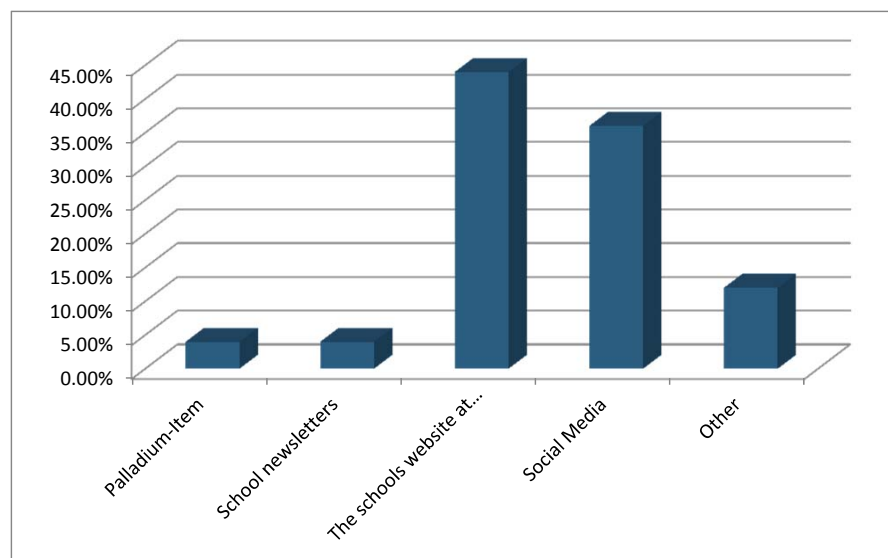

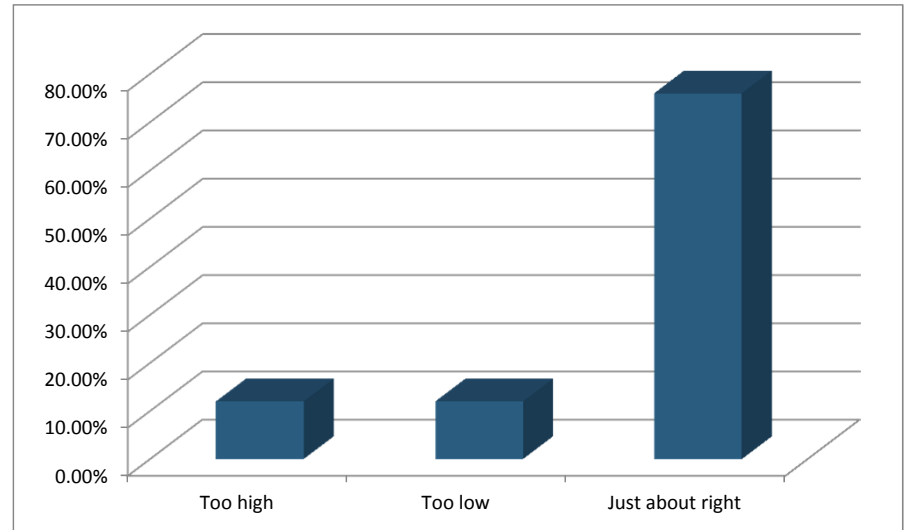

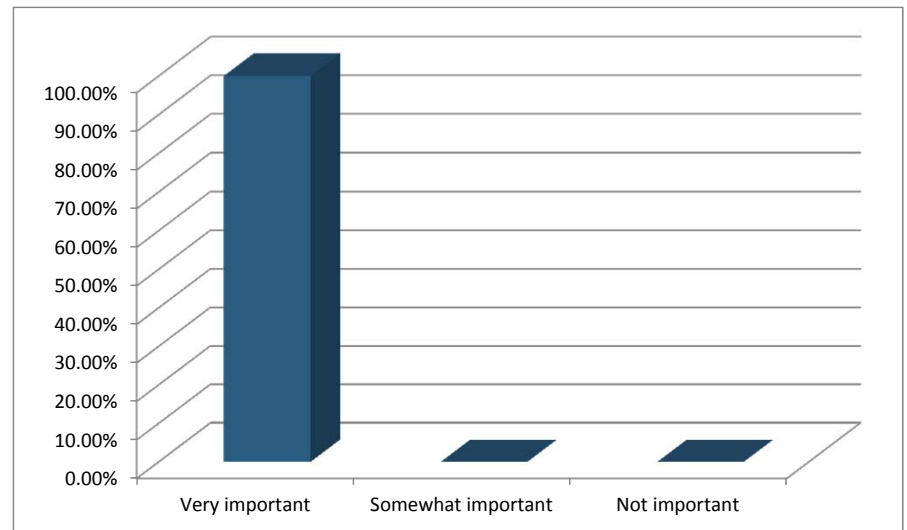

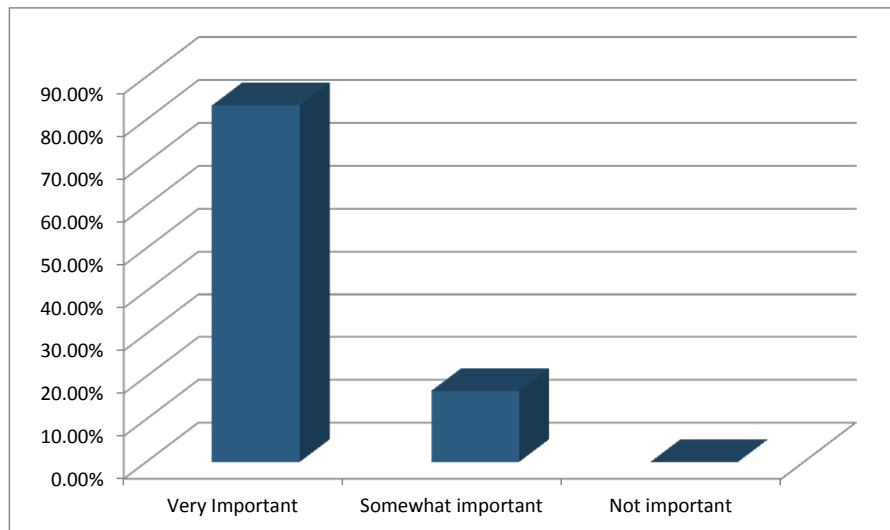

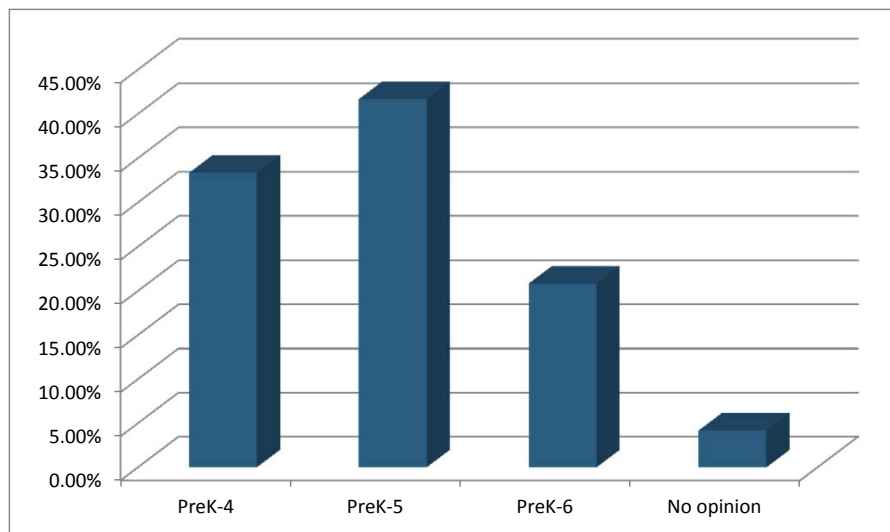

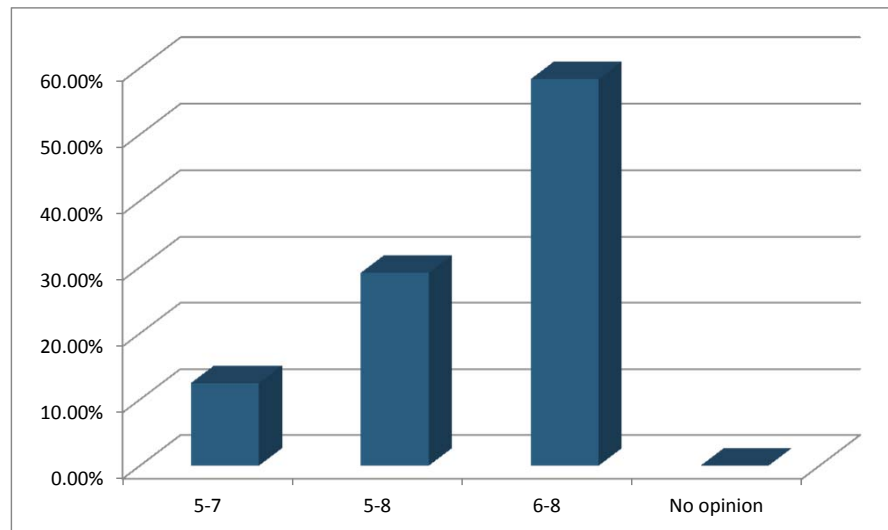

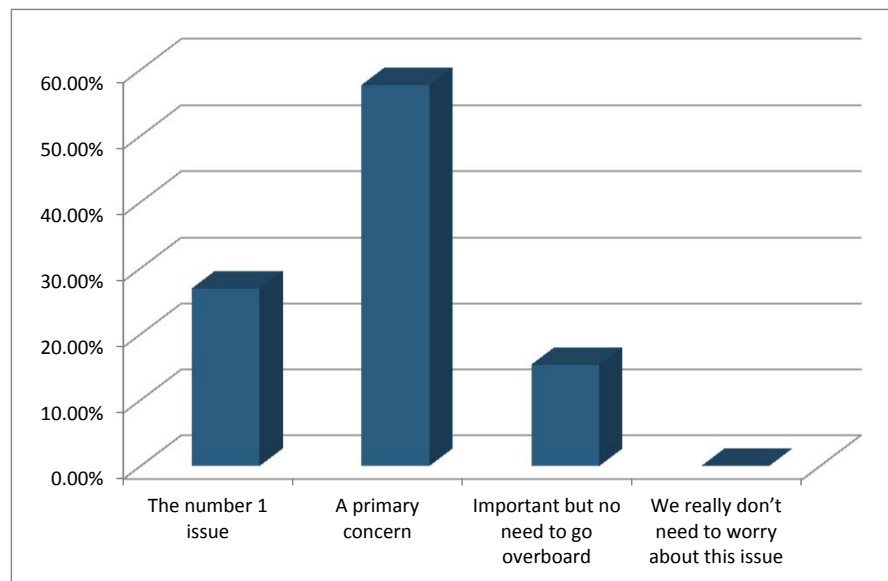

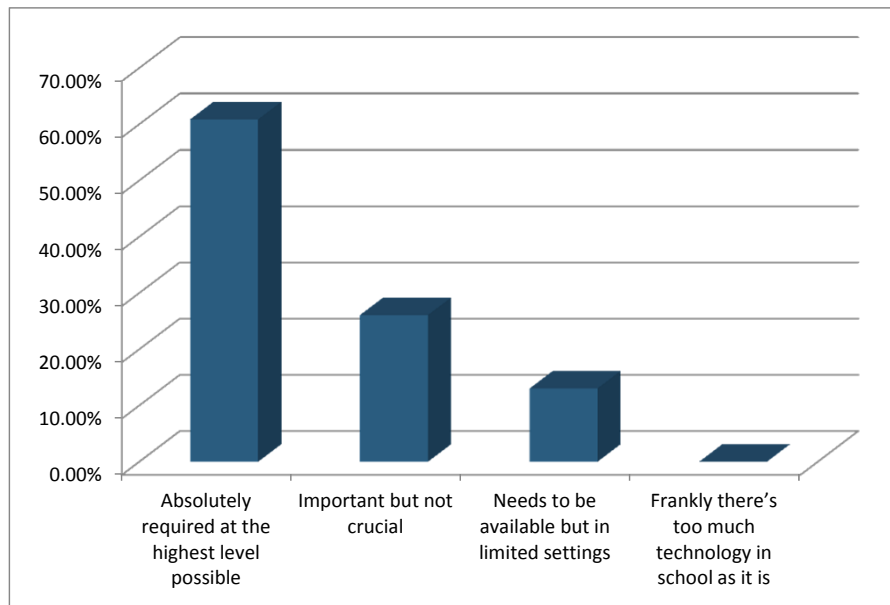

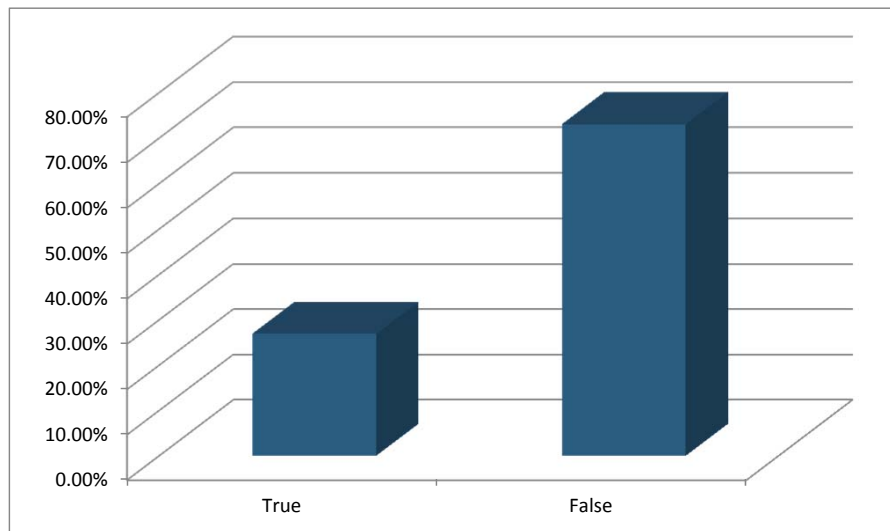

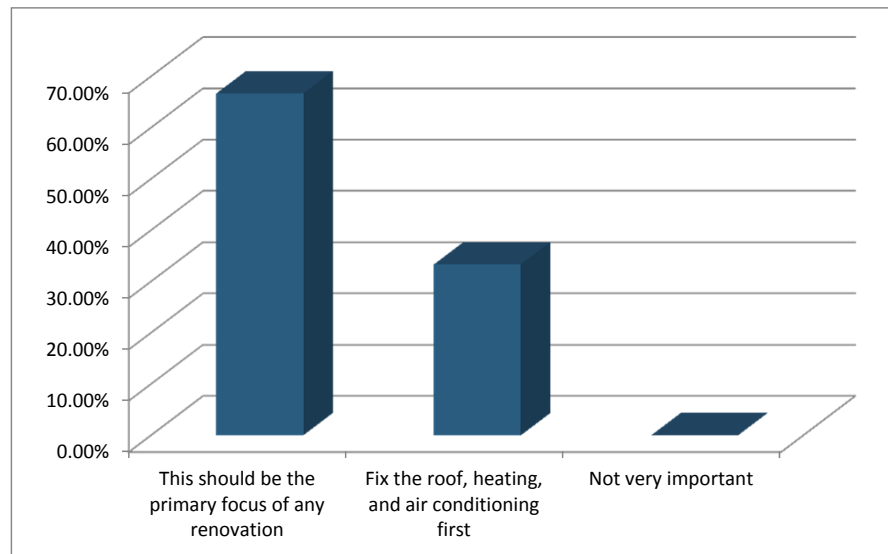

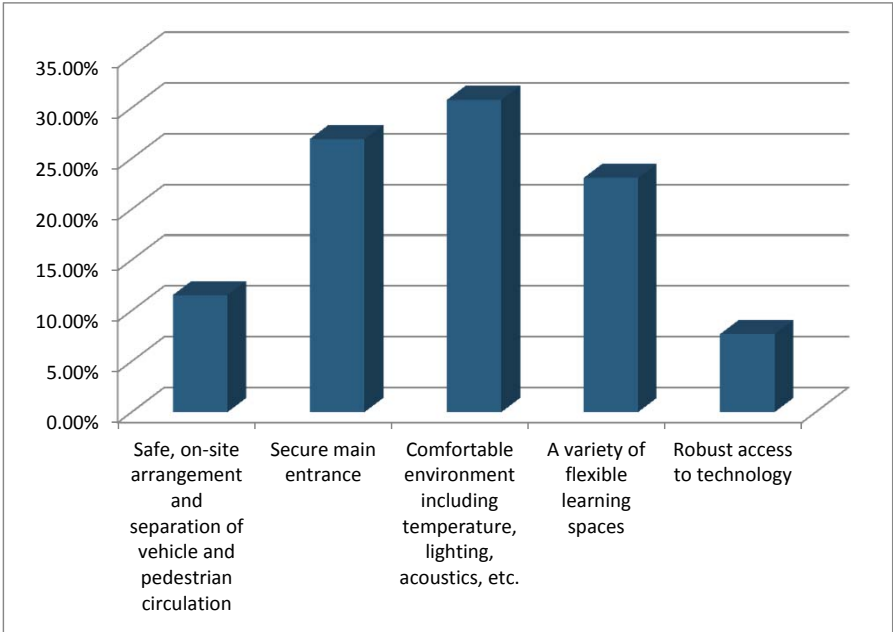

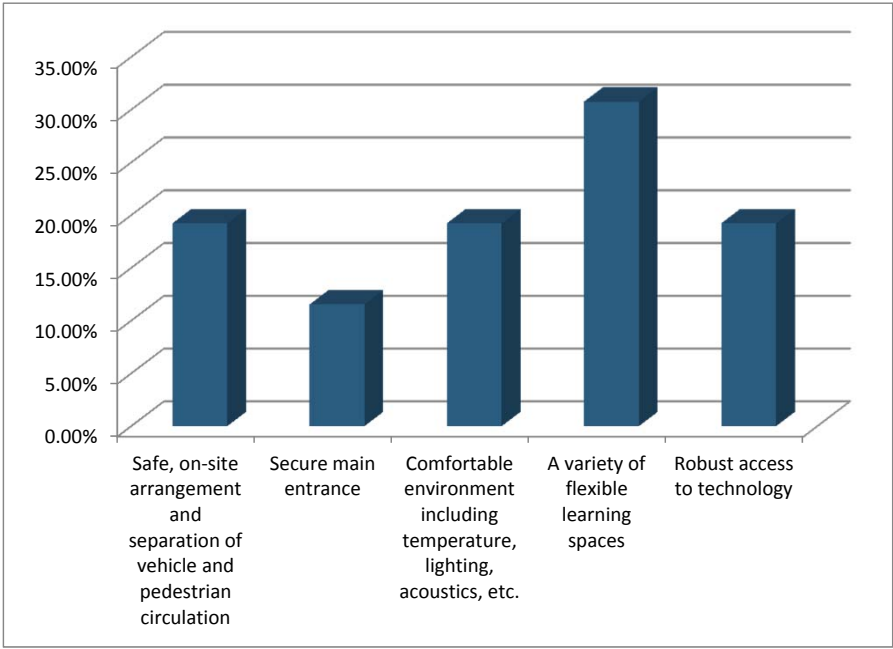

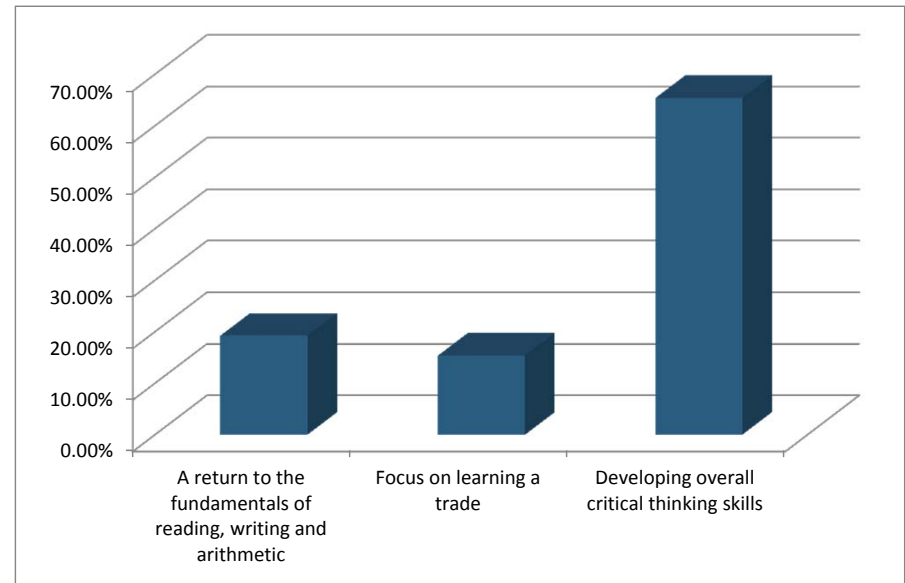

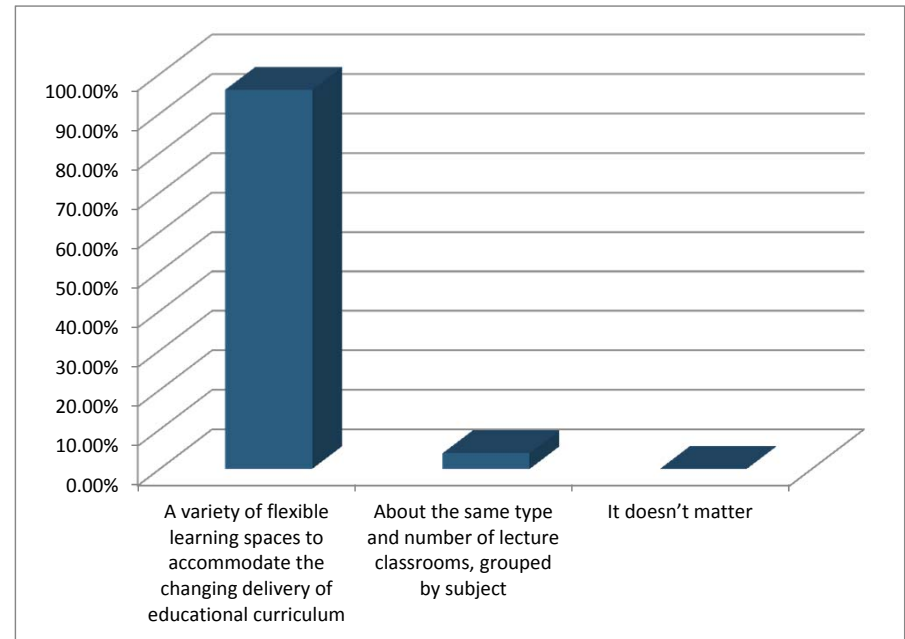
