

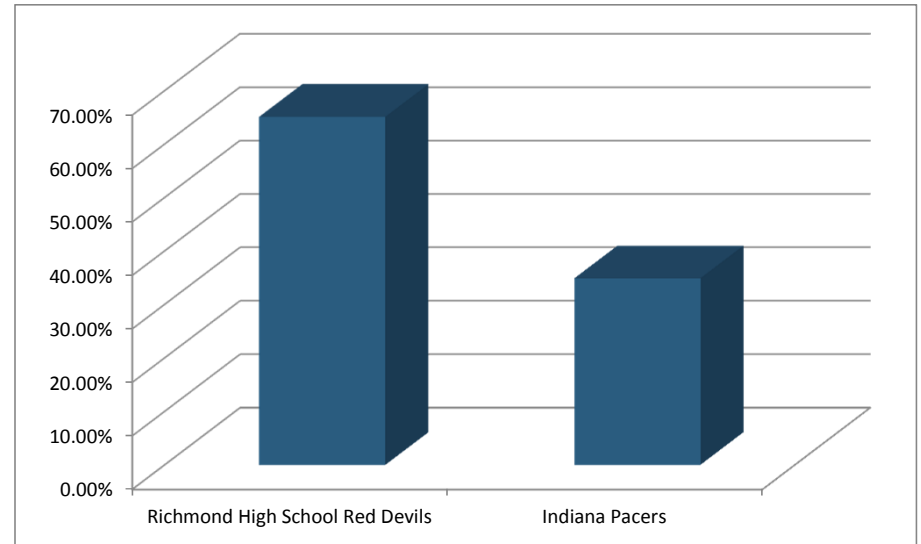

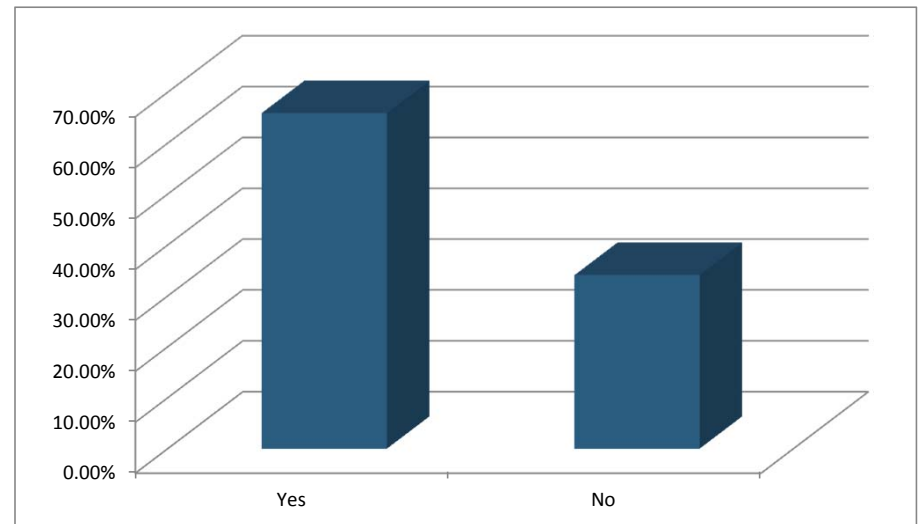
### 1. Who is going to have the better basketball season record? (Multiple Choice)

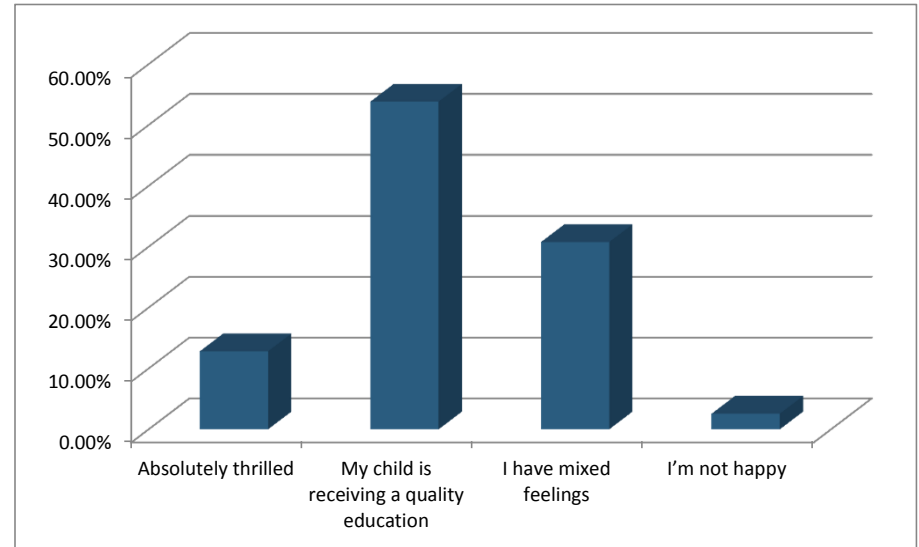
### 2. Do you have children or grandchildren attending Richmond Community Schools? (Multiple Choice)

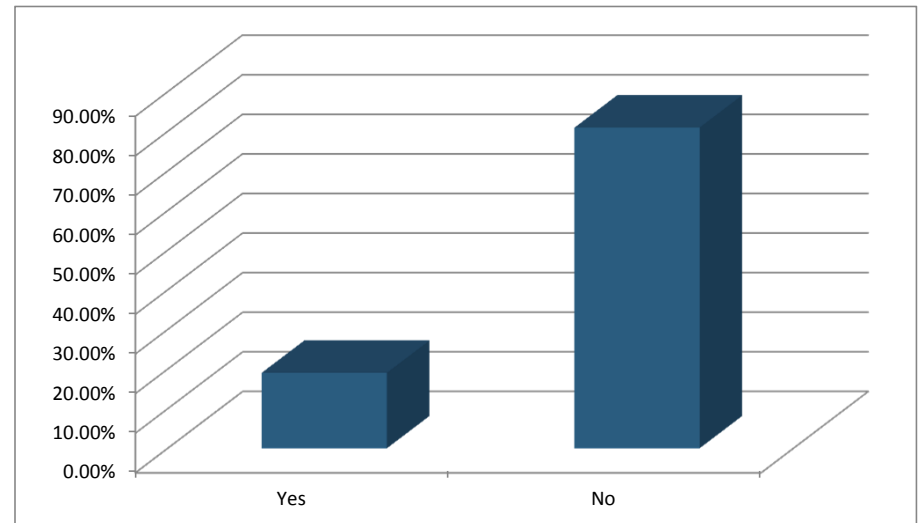

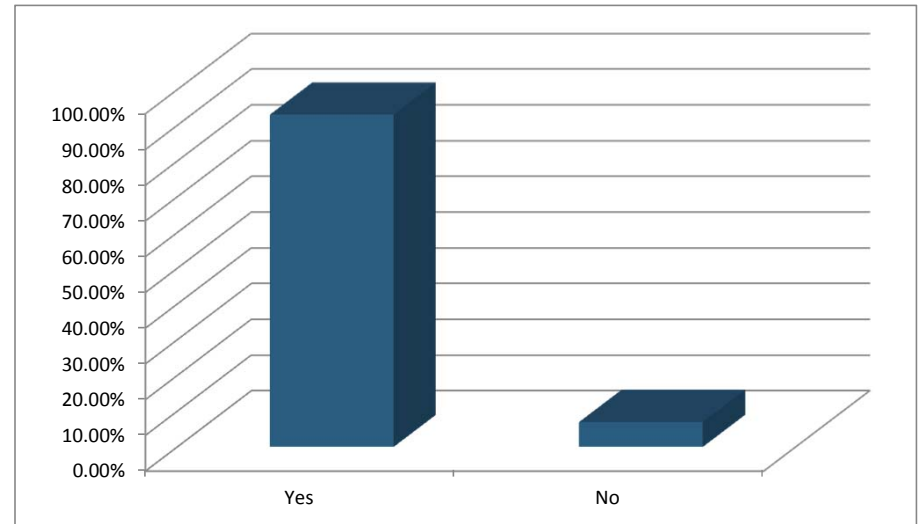

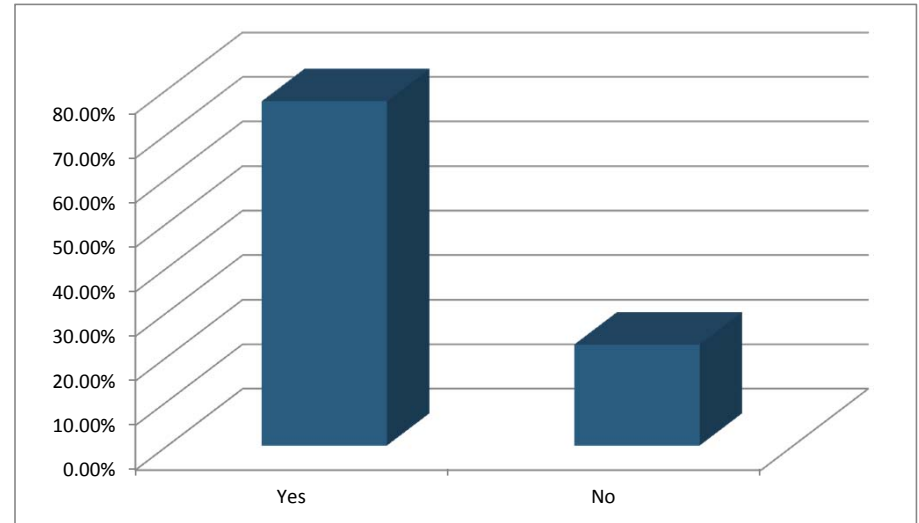
5. Within the last three years, have you visited or toured Richmond High School? (Multiple Choice)

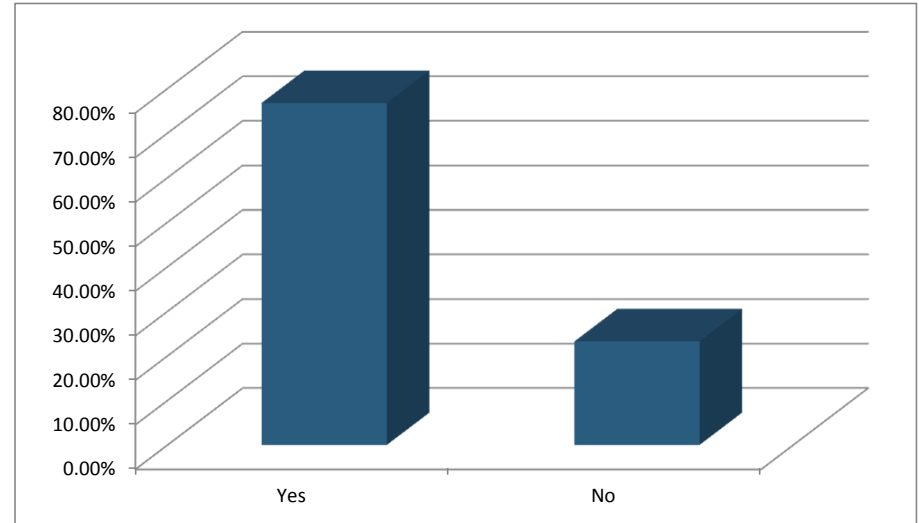
6. Within the last three years, have you recently visited or toured Dennis, Hibberd or Test Schools? (Multiple Choice)

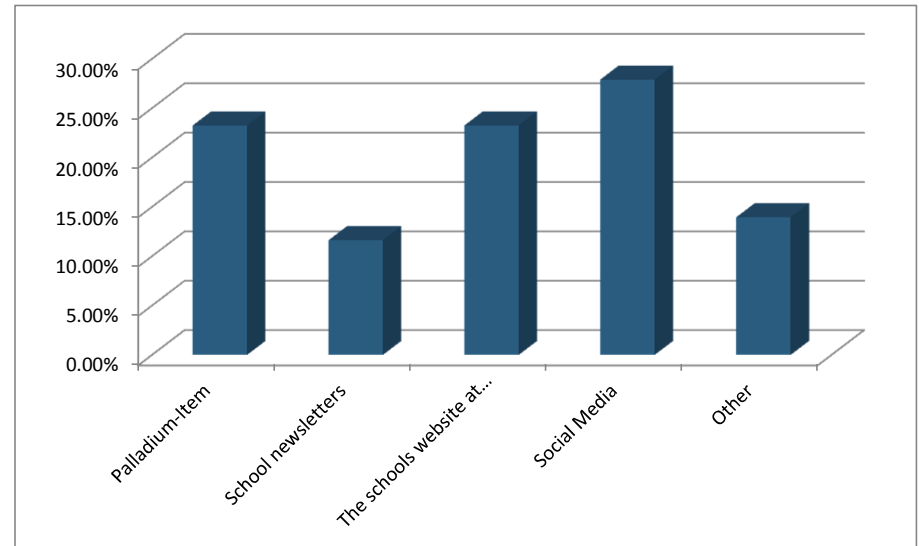
7. Within the last three years, have you recently visited or toured any of the elementary schools? (Multiple Choice)

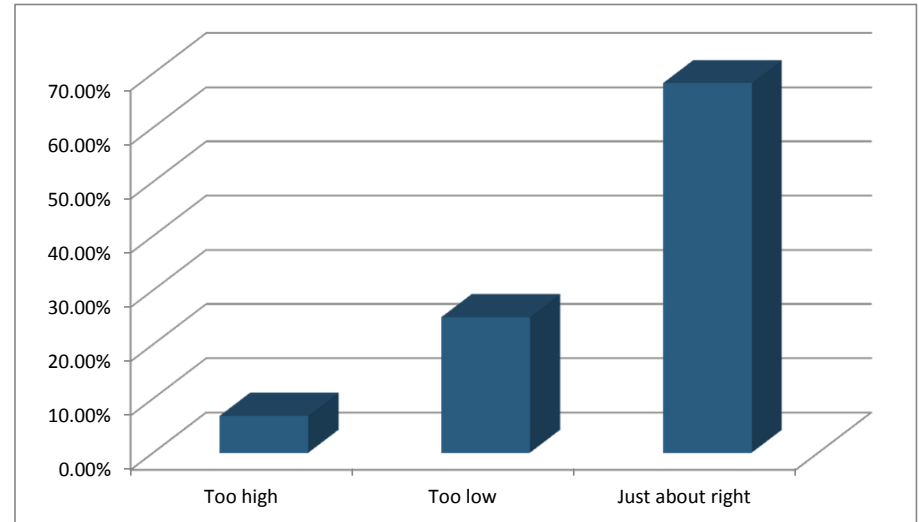
8. What source do you most often rely upon for your news regarding Richmond Community Schools? (Multiple Choice)

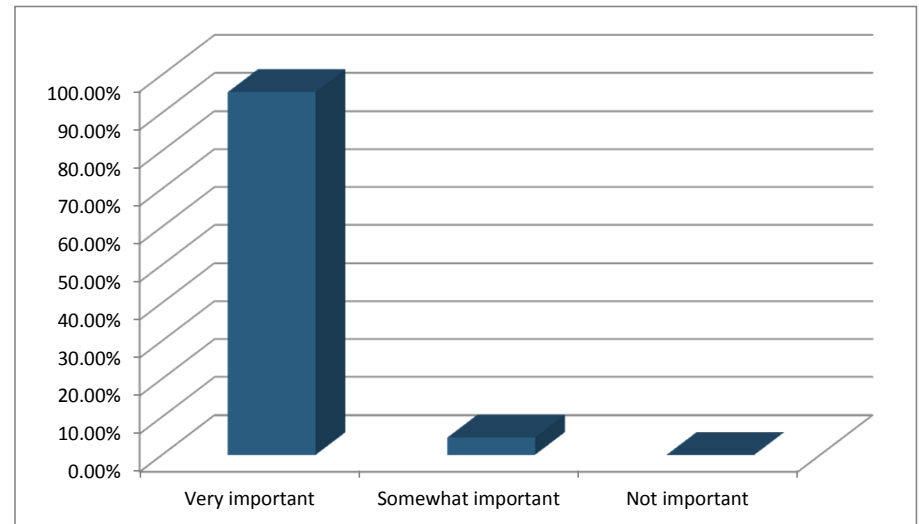

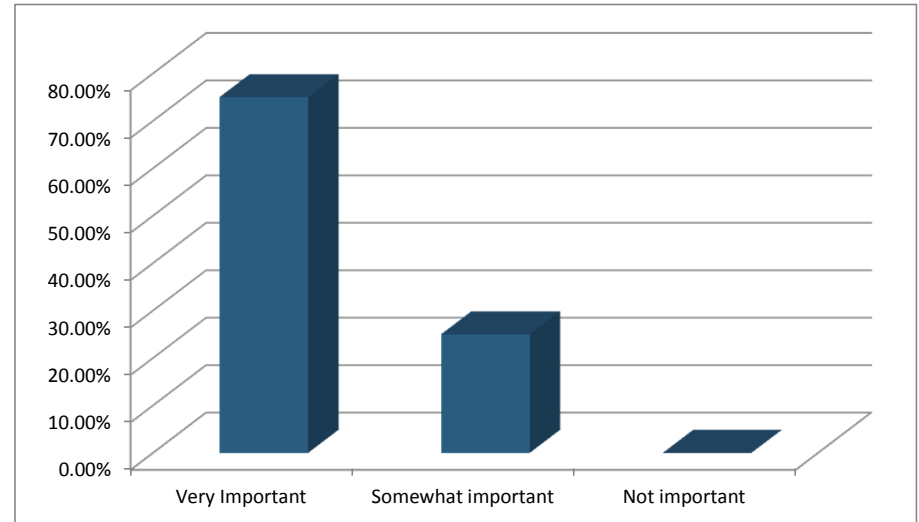

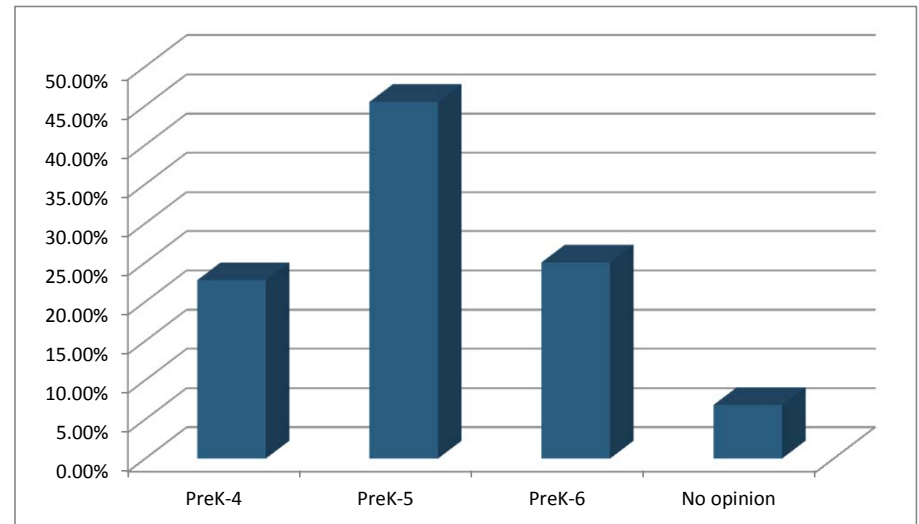

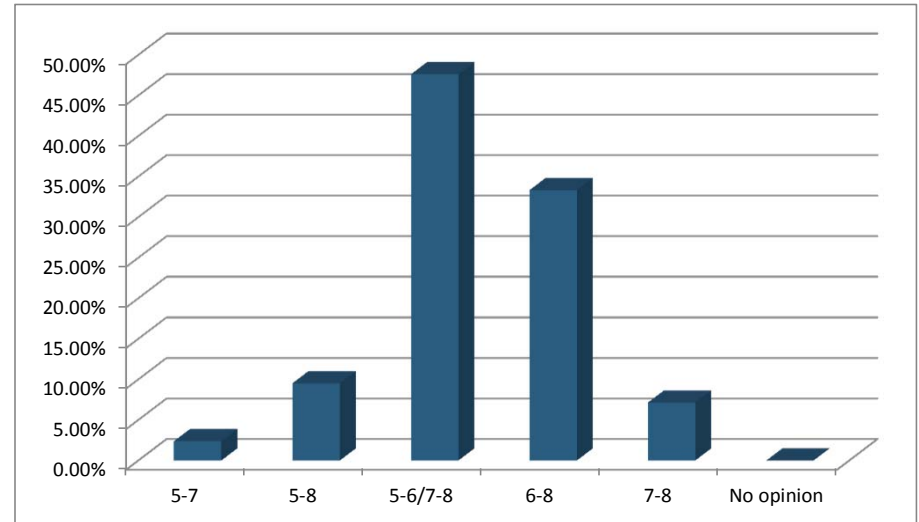

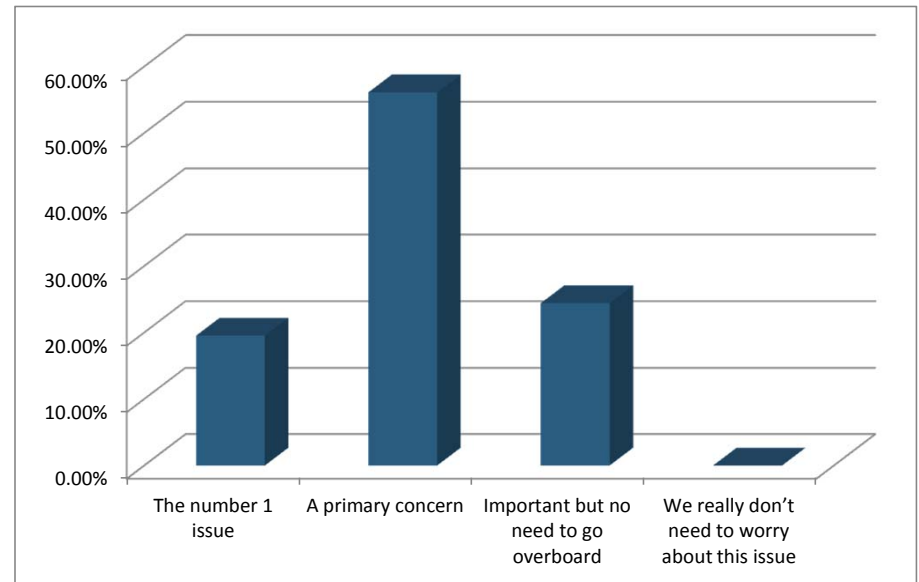

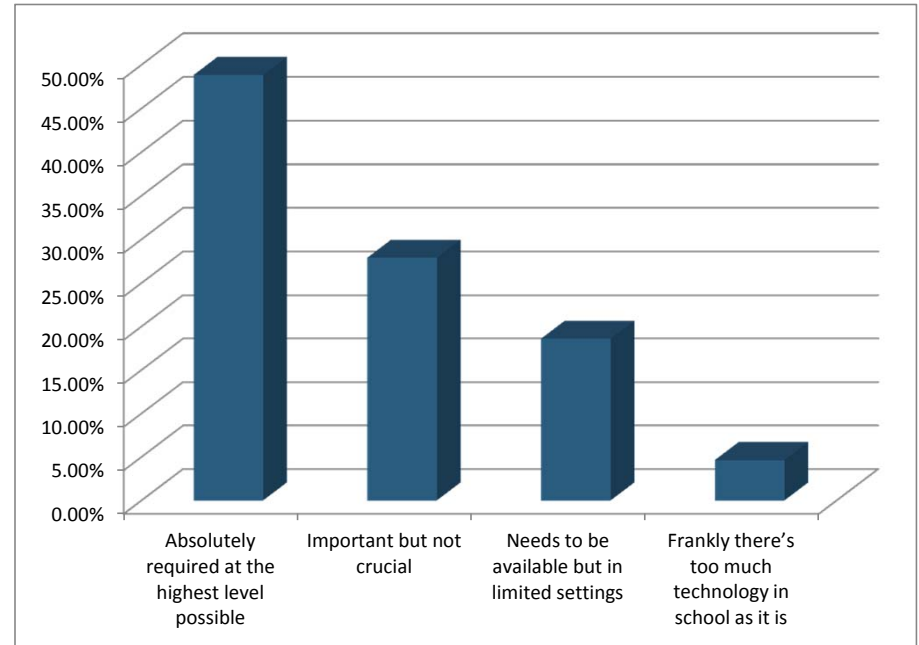

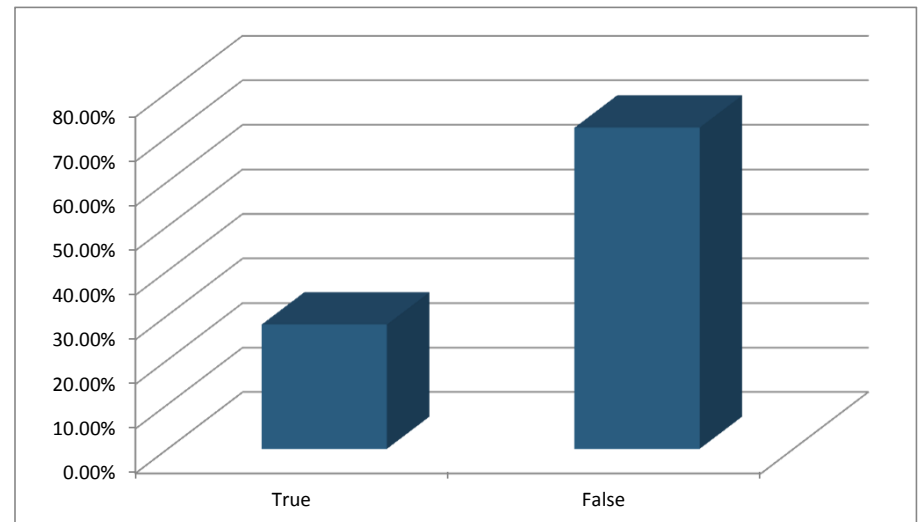

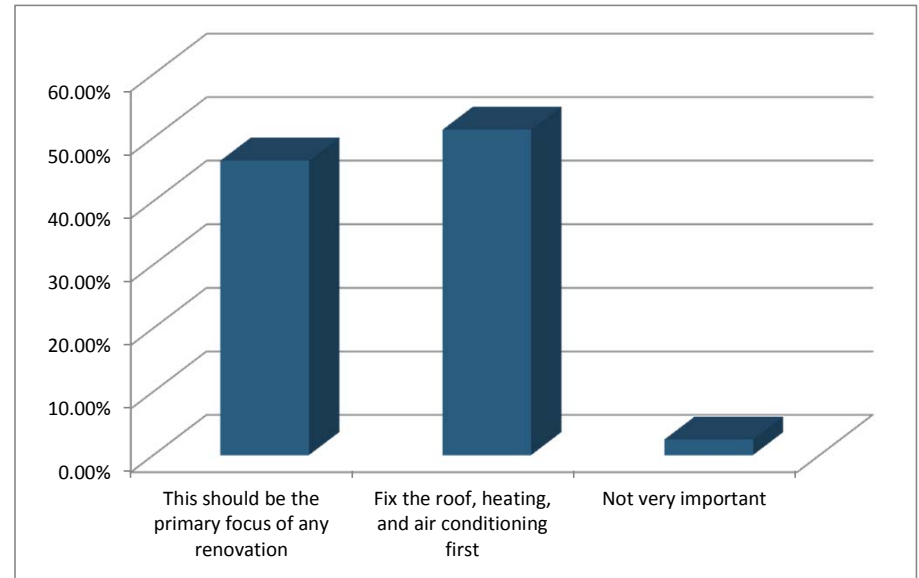

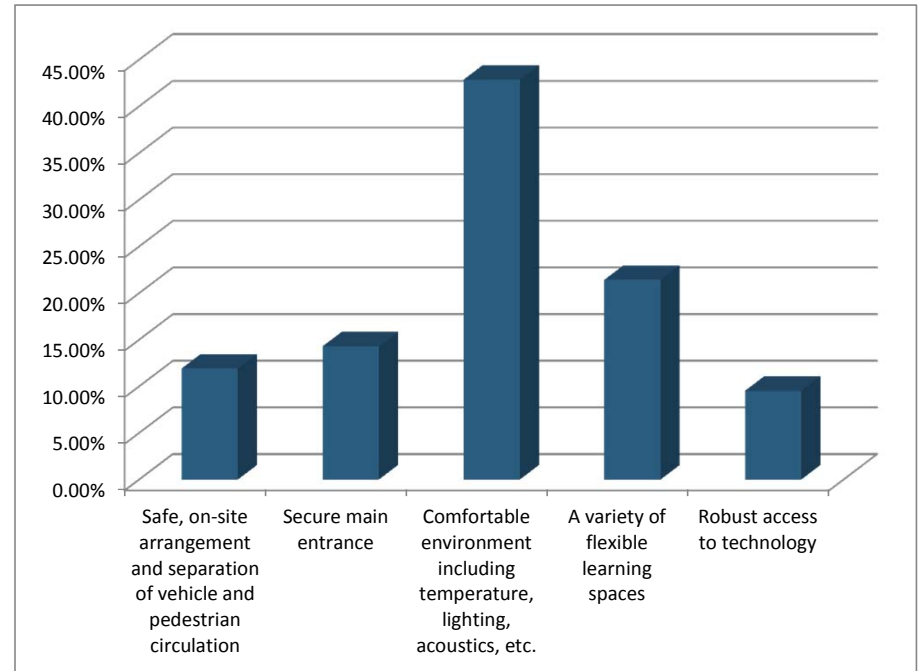

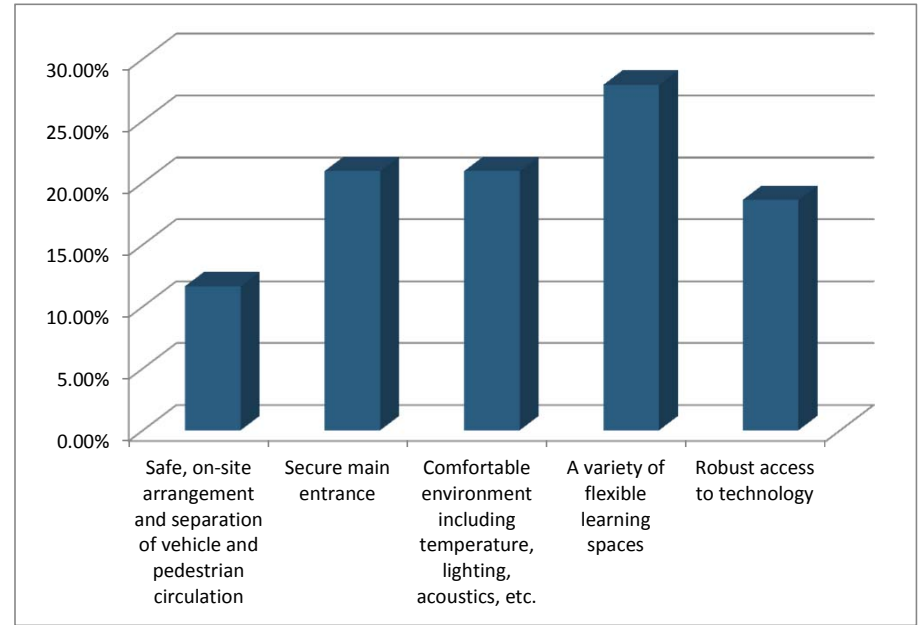

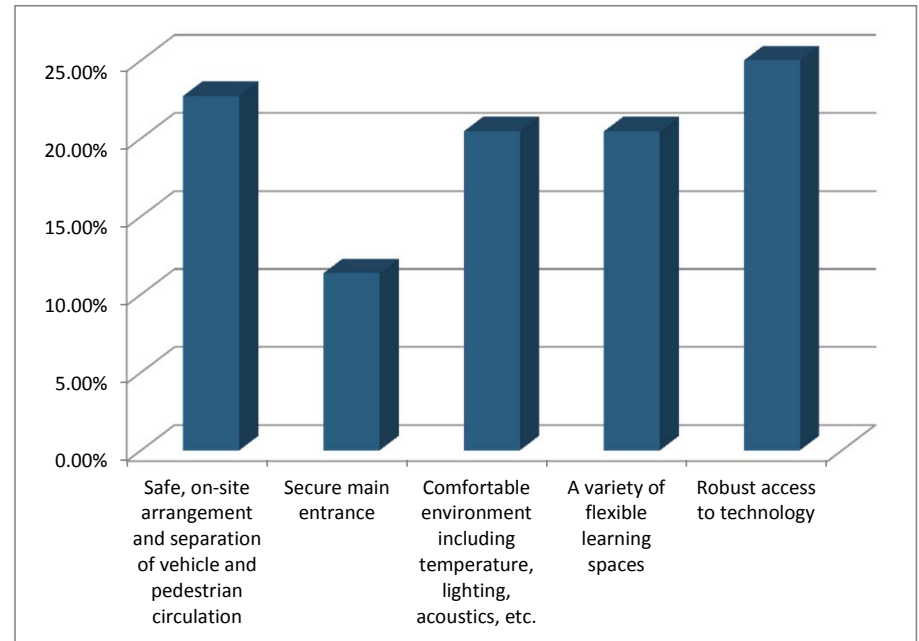

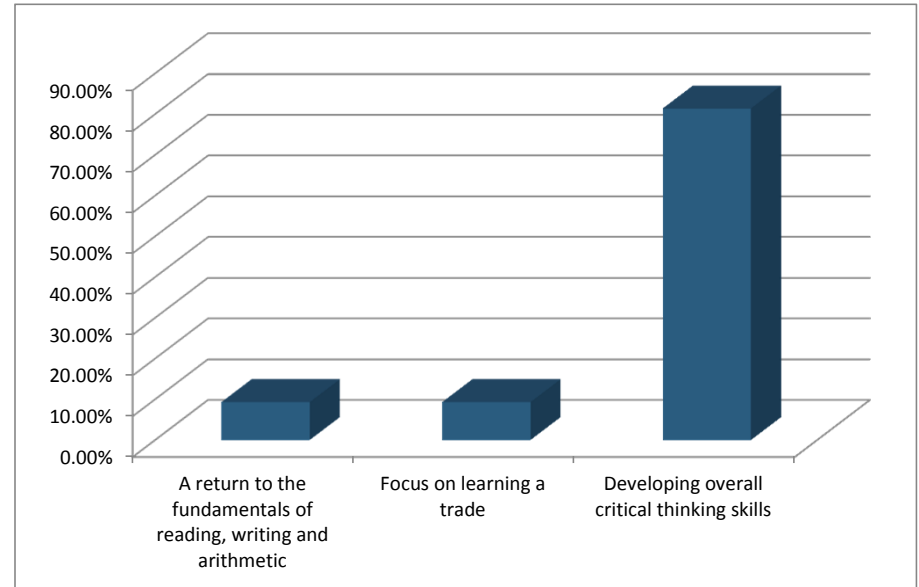

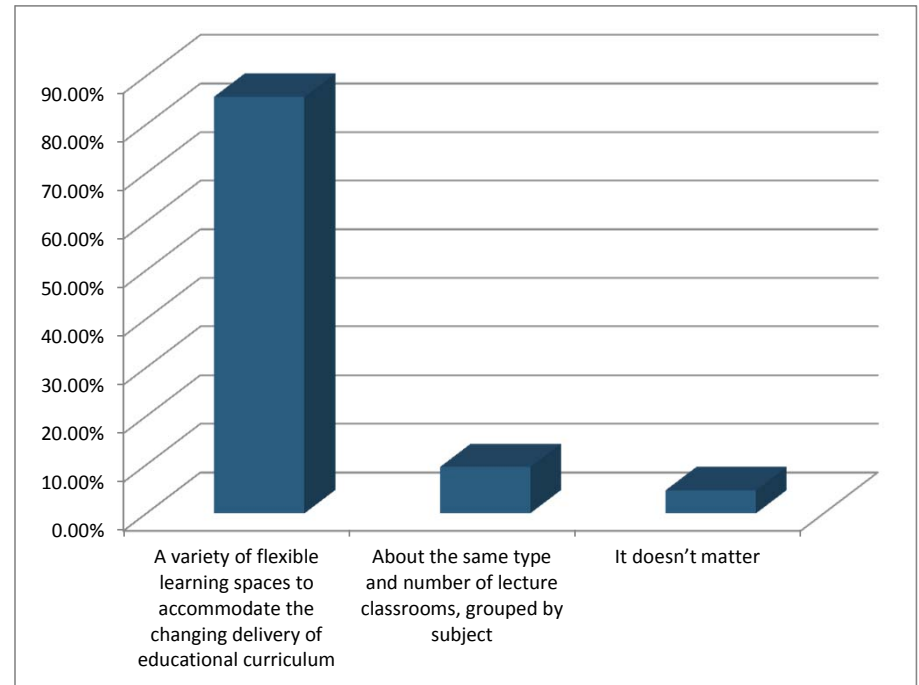

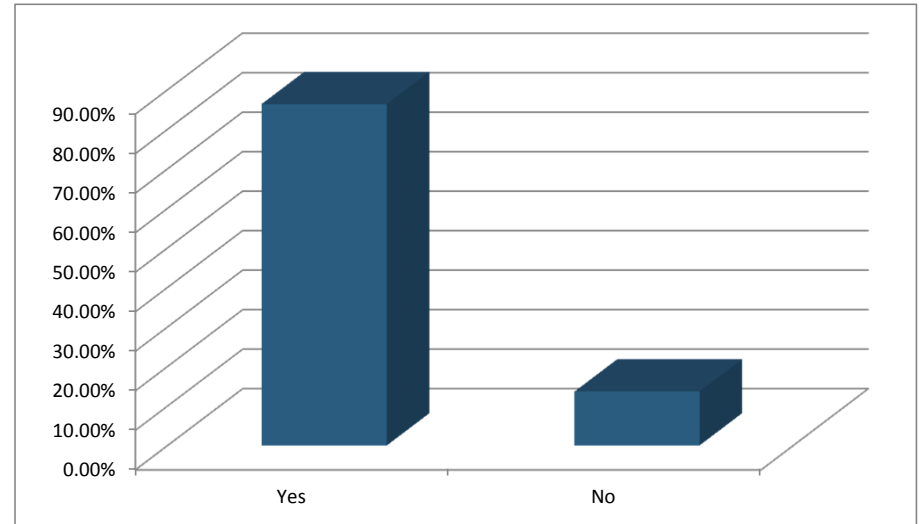
