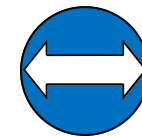

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RCS Reopening Plan

1 **Elementary Schools, Hibberd & CYS**
Students attend school in-person Monday-Friday.

2 **Dennis, Test & RHS**
Students attend school in-person 2-3 days/week and learn remotely on the opposite days.

3 **Virtual Learning**
Students learn remotely Monday-Friday. Instruction will be provided online; grading and attendance requirements apply.
Option 3 will also go into effect in the event of school closure.

Due to new procedures and virtual instruction, schools will be on an early release (Tuesday) schedule beginning August 12th to September 1st. We will return to normal hours on September 2nd, with early release on Tuesdays. The preschool schedule will remain unchanged.

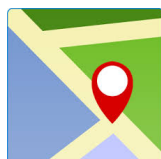

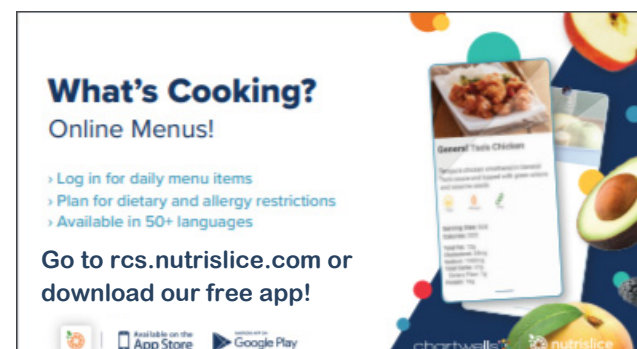
