The board members and administration send their thoughts and prayers to Aaron Stevens and his family for the recent loss of Aaron's father.

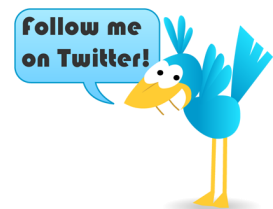


## Adjournment/Bell Ringer
