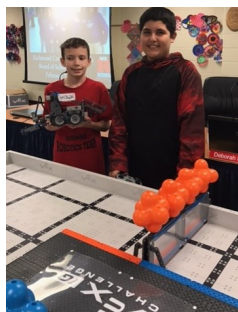
Celebrations/Reflections
