Ike Khamis

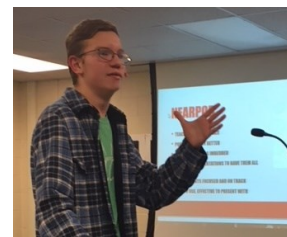
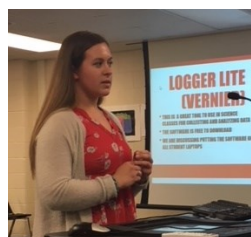
