Andrew Floyd, West End Bank School Program Coordinator gave a historical review of the partnership between RCS and West End. The program began in 2005 at Garrison Elementary. West End is now in all RCS elementary schools and at the high school. The program is designed to help students start saving. In 2018, over 416 accounts were active and over \$244,000 had been saved. West End donates 1% back to the school each year. Mr. Floyd presented the annual donation check in the amount of \$2,500.00. This year the generous donation is in collaboration with the Richmond Art Museum (RAM) and will be used to purchase a kiln.
