### Work Session

#### Bond Project Updates

Rob Tidrow, Chief Operation Officer, reviewed projects that will begin this summer 2019  
Dennis Intermediate - Roof replacement – will begin when teachers leave for the summer  
Crestdale - Roof

Test Intermediate and Dennis Intermediate tracks – Widen, clean, and put down more gravel  
(add signage across the district – regular maintenance)

Elementary Buildings and CYS – Front entrance enhancements  
Dennis Intermediate - Boiler replacement

Tiernan Center – New Lighting and PA system – will begin right after graduation  
Lybolt Field – PA system  
Charles – Gym Floor replacement

High School Student Center – decision made with Facility committee and HS principal to align the 1<sup>st</sup> floor and 2<sup>nd</sup> floor library project - continue updates that were started 6 years ago.

Tiernan Center Bleachers – 3 possible scenarios for bleachers

1. Replace drive units, code repairs \$450,000 with “paint and polish”  
Look at upper vs lower; bring back to board to look at what additional dollars can be used for
2. Replace drive units, code repairs and add safety upgrades (not required)  
Widen aisles, add handrails and steps \$850,000
3. Complete replacement of bleachers \$1.25 million

Scenario number 1 is recommended.
