Celebrations/Reflections

Dr. Chuck Reynolds, Assistant Superintendent, reported that Richmond High School offers 13 AP courses and 43 Dual credits. 30-35% of this year's seniors are on track to earn an Academic Honors Diploma and over \$2 million in scholarships have been offered, not including 21st Century Scholars. 6 of the 7 Valedictorians are in the Career Education Program. The Career Education Program offers courses in CNA, Cosmetology, Fire Rescue, Automotive, Engineering, Radio TV, Biomed, Machine Tool, H&P Tool, Drafting and Construction.

Rob Tidrow, Chief Operations Officer, updated the board on laptop breakages, wifi usage, canvas numbers and the collection of laptops. During the summer, the laptops will be reimaged and prepared for deployment at the beginning of the next school year.

Board Reports/Discussion

The board discussed the process of responding to community members that speak during the public commentary portion of the board meetings.
