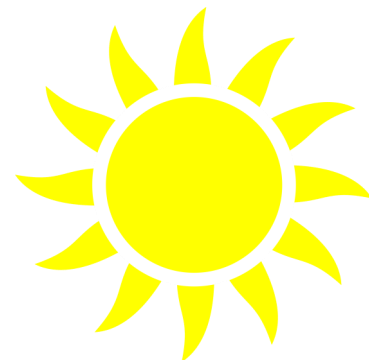
RCS will be hosting a Youth Summit, July 12, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. with the youth and adult leaders in our community.
