Community, Staff, and Student Input Requested from School Board

RICHMOND, October 29, 2020 – The Richmond Community School Board of Trustees believes it is critical to obtain community input about the desired characteristics of the next Superintendent as well as the challenges and opportunities that they will encounter. The board of trustees has been in the process of implementing a collaborative approach to governance which includes listening to stakeholders across the board, including parents, students, teachers, community members, alumni, etc.

In an effort to gather information from members of each of these key groups and move the strategic plan forward, an online survey has been posted and we strongly encourage everyone, from all stakeholder groups, to respond and provide their input. A link to the survey can be found below and will be available until December 1, 2020.

The last question of the survey asks if you would like to participate in a live virtual focus group meeting. The intent of the virtual meeting is to engage, in more depth, in the information requested in the survey. We expect these meetings to be 60 to 90 minutes in length and limited to groups of 25 or 30 attendees. The number of virtual meetings depends on the interest of our participants.
