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WORK SESSION

Literacy: Board members discussed short term priorities for literacy. A Special Work Session to continue this discussion will take place on Thursday, January 13, 2011. CPASS results will also be discussed at that meeting.

ACTION ITEMS

Human Resources: Approval of the Administrative Contracts through June 30, 2011 for Rae Woolpy and Kathy Parker and the Administrative Contract through June 30, 2012 for Barbara Bergdoll. There was discussion on organizational flow charts and revising administrative contracts.

Hibberd Pool—Request for Proposals: Approval of the finding that it is not feasible to hire fair market value appraisals for the Hibberd Pool and approval of the Request for Permission to Advertise for Request for Proposals for Short Term Lease of the Hibberd Pool as presented.

FOLLOW UP—OLD BUSINESS

Update on District Voting Plan: David Stidham reminded the public that, in order to have three equally balanced voting districts, the Board approved a reorganizational plan on September 22, 2010. This plan was published on September 30, 2010 and the 120 day waiting period for response will end on January 28, 2011. At that time, if no changes are to be made, the school attorney will submit the plan to the Department of Education for approval.
