WORK SESSION

Budget Assumptions and Overview of Taxing Funds and Budget Strategy: Bob Coddington discussed the 65% solution, which refers to the percentage of funds going directly to classrooms. Richmond Community Schools is at 69.2%. Mr. Coddington provided an overview of the taxing funds and discussed the process, strategy, and development of the 2011 budget.

Dr. Bourff stated that due to budget reasons it has not been recommended to extend the administrative two and three year contracts by one year as has been done in the past. The Board approved the recommendation of the Superintendent to not extend his contract by one year for budget reasons only.

SNAPSHOTS OF SUCCESS

Recognition of Outgoing Board President: Suzanne Derengowski was presented with a plaque in recognition of serving as the Board of School Trustees President from 2008 to 2010.

REPORTS

Food Service Report: Maggie LaRue presented information on the Mini Food Show, equipment purchases, support for student academic achievement, number of meals and snacks served, budget, summer feeding programs, plans for the next school year, reauthorization of School Lunch Act, and expectations.

District Voting Plan: David Stidham discussed options for creating more competition for elections for school board positions. Options include leaving things as they are, making all seven seats at-large, or reconfiguring district boundaries. A discussion followed on equity of representation, removing barriers, timing of elections, staggered seating of new members, and other topics.
