#### **REPORTS/DISCUSSION TOPICS**

State of Schools Report: Dr. Bourff stated that the Richmond Community Schools Year in Review Report was presented on June 25, 2013 at Crestdale Elementary School. In the powerpoint presented at that event information regarding End of Course Assessments was not correct. From 2011-2012 to 2012-2013 Algebra ECA scores decreased by 2.5% and English ECA scores increased by 2.9%. <u>2013-2014 Strategic Plan</u>: Dr. Bourff stated that the Richmond Education Association has agreed to be a part of the strategic planning process; however, a draft plan could not be completed in time to bring to the Board meeting for discussion.

Safe Schools/Healthy Students Report: Misty Hollis provided a brief history of the Safe Students/Healthy Students grant and shared information regarding the draft final report from the evaluators at the Indiana University Center for Evaluation and Education Policy. A Financial Report and Director's Report will be submitted within 90 days. Many of the services and partnerships that were established through the grant will be maintained after the grant is closed on June 30, 2013.

High Ability Report: Gwinn Gibbs reviewed the High Ability identification process and the various programs offered, including ASPIRE and WINGS. Following a discussion, Dr. Bourff stated that he will be proposing a college coaching position to be based at Hibberd, but also to work with Dennis and Test students. This position would also help transition eighth grade students to the high school.

<u>Donations</u>: Acceptance of \$8,283.50 in Donations. <u>West End Bank</u>: Approval of 2013-2014 Agreement with West End Bank.

School Improvement Plans: Approval of the draft School Improvement Plans. Dr. Parker stated that the School Improvement Plans are draft due to ISTEP+ scores not being available. Statute requires the plans be presented to the Board in June.

<u>Sabbatical Request</u>: Approval of a one year unpaid Sabbatical for LaTrisha Jackson.
