TEST INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL ANNOUNCES TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE DURING DISMISSAL

RICHMOND, IN August 8, 2016 – On August 4, Lt. Curt Leverton (Richmond Police Department) and Rob Tidrow (RCS Chief Operations Officer) presented a proposal to the Richmond Board of Public Works and Safety meeting. They requested the meeting to discuss closing South A Street between South 22nd Street and South 23rd Street (directly south of Test



Intermediate School) for approximately 35 minutes each day at the end of school. This will reduce traffic congestion and assist with overall safety of students at the end of the day. The safety proposal was created after meeting with school administrators and reviewing the options with the Richmond Police Department. The proposal was approved unanimously, with favorable comments from Vicki Robinson, president of the Richmond Board of Public Works and Safety.

“The closing of South A street each day at dismissal time provides an extra layer of safety for our students who are walking home or catching a ride with parents or guardians,” stated Chief Operations Officer Rob Tidrow. “We thank the Richmond Police Department and the Richmond Board of Public Works and Safety for providing us this opportunity for our students.”
