Tony Lewis Named as New Varsity Football Coach for Richmond High School

RICHMOND, February 28, 2018 – The Richmond High School Athletic Department is excited to announce the appointment of Tony Lewis as the new head varsity football coach. Coach Lewis has most recently served as the Head Football Coach at Crystal River High School in Crystal River, Florida. Prior to that, he was the Head Football Coach at Henderson County High School, F.J. Reitz High School in Evansville and Wheelersburg High School in Wheelersburg, Ohio.

Coach Lewis has a career record as a head coach of 129-57 in 16 years. At Wheelersburg, he won four Southern Ohio Conference Championships in his six year tenure and was named Southern Ohio Coach of the Year four times. At Reitz High School in Evansville, he won three SIAC championship, three sectionals, two regionals, one semi-state and one state championship in 2009 with an undefeated record of 15-0. He also led Crystal River to their first playoff since 2008 in 2016. He also has been a featured speaker at many coaching clinics including the Nike Coach of the Year Clinic. Coach Lewis was a long-time assistant under state championship coach Bob Gaddis before starting his head coaching career.

Mr. Lewis has a Bachelor's of Science degree in Secondary Education from Indiana University and a Master's of Science degree in Education from the University of Southern Indiana.

Coach Lewis will be meeting with the returning players at RHS in the near future to introduce himself, discuss offseason conditioning and establish goals for the upcoming season. He will also work with the Athletic Director in filling his assistant coaching positions in the upcoming weeks.
